

# Indian Peaks Wilderness Regulations



## **Pets:**

Pets must be on a hand held leash at all times for their protection as well as wildlife and other persons using the area.



## **Camping Permits:**

A permit is required for anyone camping between June 1 and September 15. Maximum group size is 12 people or a combination of people and pack stock.



## **Camping:**

Camping in the following zones is restricted to numbered, designated sites:

Diamond Lake      Jasper Lake      Crater Lake      Caribou Lake

Camping is prohibited within 100 feet of all lakes, streams, or developed trails.

Camping is prohibited in the Four Lakes Backcountry Zone from May 1 through November 30.



## **Day and Special Use Permits:**

A permit is required for all *organized groups* (i.e. scout troops, church groups, clubs) and *outfitter/ guides* entering the Indian Peaks Wilderness anytime of year.

Maximum group size is 12 people or a combination of people and pack stock.



## **Campfires:**

Campfires are prohibited **east** of the Continental Divide in the IPW.

Campfires are prohibited in the following areas **west** of the Continental Divide.

Crater Lake      Caribou Lake      Gourd Lake      Columbine Lake

Cascade Creek above Cascade Falls (including Pawnee Lake)



## **Motorized and Mechanical Equipment:**

Bicycles, motorized equipment, drones, wagons, motor vehicles, hang gliders, strollers, or other vehicles, except wheeled devices that aid mobility-impaired individuals are prohibited.

## **Pack Stock:**

Pack stock are prohibited in the following areas:

Four Lakes Backcountry Zone

Diamond Lake Trail

Cascade Creek Backcountry Zone above Cascade Falls

Hobbled, tethered, or picketed pack stock are prohibited within 100 feet of lakes, streams, or developed trails.

Only certified weed-free oats, hay, or pelletized feed allowed.
