

Vasquez Wilderness Regulations

Maximum group size is 12 heartbeats (combination of people and pack stock).



Pets: Pets must be under control at all times.



Camping:

Camping is prohibited within 100 feet of all lakes, streams, and trails.



Campfires:

Campfires are prohibited within 100 feet of all lakes, streams, and trails.



Motorized and Mechanical Equipment:

Bicycles, motorized equipment, wagons, motor vehicles, hang gliders, strollers, or other vehicles, except wheeled devices that aid mobility-impaired individuals are prohibited.



Pack Stock:

Hobbled, tethered, or picketed pack stock are prohibited within 100 feet of all lakes, streams, or developed trails. Only certified weed-free oats, hay, or pelletized feed are allowed.



Day and Special Use Permits:

A permit is required for all *organized groups* (i.e. scout troops, church groups, clubs) and *outfitter/ guides* entering the Byers Peak Wilderness anytime of year.
