

Indian Peaks Wilderness Permit Application

Complete this form in its entirety to receive a permit.

- A \$5.00 permit is required per group for overnight camping in the Indian Peaks Wilderness Area between June 1 and September 15. The fee covers the group for the planned trip.
- To receive a permit in person: print and complete this application and bring it to the Boulder or Granby office with your \$5.00 payment.
- A day hike permit is required year round for large groups (8 to 12 people) at no cost. Inquire by telephone. Small groups of 1 to 7 people do not need a group permit.
- Mailed applications are also acceptable. Please send in the completed application with a \$5.00 check or money order made payable to USDA Forest Service per trip. Mail to either address below. **Allow two weeks to receive your permit by mail.**
